The first was from an official of Cape May County to Jacob Spicer. They are giving him notice about a fishery that is part of the land that he recently purchased. The county is contacting him about a previous request that was made to preserve the fishery and a Remonstrance request. They were denying this request. Jacob Spicer responded that many people shared the sentiment that the fishery should be preserved.
