Margaret Barnett, wife of late Edward Barnett, applied to the court for a division of Mr. Barnett's real estate. The court agreed and appointed commissioners Ezekiel Stevens, Aaron Crowell, and Enoch Edmunds who would divide the land fairly among Mr. Barnett's heirs according to his will. The rest of the document details each of the pieces of real estate to be divided among Mr. Barnett's two heirs - Ethu and Philip Barnett.
